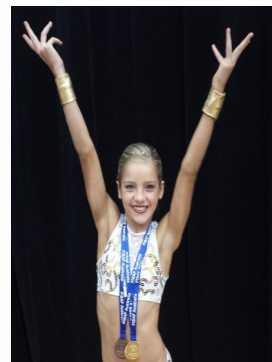

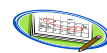

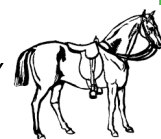


### ICAS English Competition

A **BIG** reminder to return all raffle tickets sold or unsold to school as the Opera House Raffle will be drawn tomorrow, Thursday.

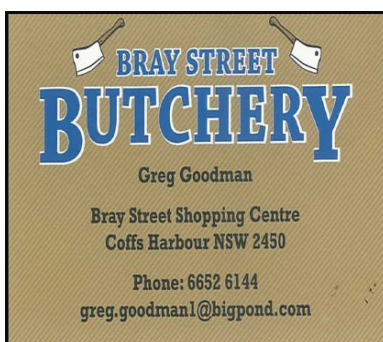


Tickets can still be purchased up until Thursday morning. Your child will need to see the ticket sellers first thing in the morning.
