Michael had dreams like most children & the undying determination to achieve the impossible... No matter the size of the obstacles that lay ahead. Now, an accomplished businessman, National Ambassador for Camp Quality, Australian of the Year finalist, Australia Day Ambassador & International Hall of Fame inductee, Michael inspires people from all walks of life. He certainly inspired the 120 school leaders who were in the auditorium.

It is no doubt he has a heart for giving & a skill to engage people from all walks of life. After following his dreams of playing baseball in the USA, and having these dreams cut short through illness, Michael had a very successful career in finance in Australia. He gave up this lifestyle to lead a life of global impact in more ways than one.



Michael's story "Field of Dreams" was documented on Australian Story, ABC TV television. Through this documentary, his message touched the hearts of a nation, with his story of how he overcame seemingly insurmountable obstacles to achieve success in both his personal and professional life. Recently Michael featured in a humanitarian documentary which highlighted the countless lives he has saved through his orphanage and school in Haiti.

If ever you have the chance to hear Michael speak, you will not be disappointed. He shows what can be done when you find your voice, your passion and work towards achieving your goals.
