Dear Families,

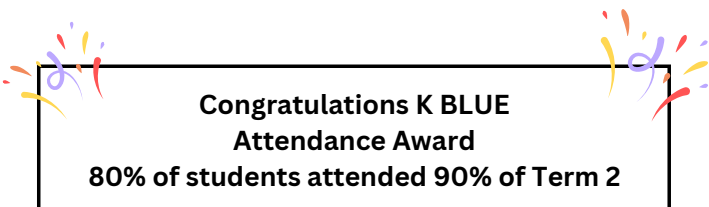
Term 2 has certainly flown by, with lots of fantastic opportunities occurring for all our Kororo students.

Principal's message continued

Enrolment applications for kindergarten 2025 are open. Kororo Public School students, teachers and families are a fabulous community and I encourage you to continue to share our great results, efforts and opportunities with the wider community, ensuring our schools wonderful reputation continues.

Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with Disability (NCCD)

Every year, all schools in Australia participate in the Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with Disability (NCCD). The NCCD process requires schools to identify information already available in the school about supports provided to students with a disability. These relate to legislative requirements under the Disability Discrimination Act 1992 and the Disability Standards for Education 2005, in line with the NCCD guidelines (2019).

Information provided about students to the Australian Government for the NCCD includes:

- year of schooling
- category of disability: physical, cognitive, sensory or social/emotional
- level of adjustment provided: support provided within quality differentiated teaching practice, supplementary, substantial or extensive.

This information assists schools to:

- formally recognise the supports and adjustments provided to students with disability in schools
- consider how they can strengthen the support of students with disability in schools
- develop shared practices so that they can review their learning programs in order to improve educational outcomes for students with disability.

The NCCD provides state and federal governments with the information they need to plan more broadly for the support of students with a disability. Teachers at Kororo Public School have been completing this data collection process throughout the year and collating this information in the past two weeks.

The NCCD will have no direct impact on your child and your child will not be involved in any testing process. The school will provide data to the Australian Government in such a way that no individual student will be able to be identified – the privacy and confidentiality of all students is ensured. All information is protected by privacy laws that regulate the collection, storage and disclosure of personal information.

Tell Them From Me

Throughout this term, students have completed the Tell Them From Me survey. This survey, which measures student engagement and wellbeing, has provided our students with a clear voice and avenue to give feedback on their learning experience. As a teaching staff, we review these results to identify areas of action to best support students. The results have been overwhelmingly positive, with an increase in students' sense of belonging, which were already well above state average, increasing by an additional 4% from 2023 to 2024. This is a testament to the quality experiences our students are provided with and their enjoyment of their time at school.

At the beginning of term 4, the parent component of the Tell Them From Me survey will be released. I strongly encourage you to use this avenue to provide feedback to the school on your experience here at Kororo. Additionally, our P & C meets every third Monday of the month. This is a valuable opportunity for you to give feedback and positively affect change within our school community. Your input is highly valued and can make a real difference.

NAIDOC

This Thursday, 4th July, Kororo Public School is hosting a NAIDOC assembly. As part of our NAIDOC celebrations, students have been engaging in lessons where they have been learning the local language through song and stories through art. 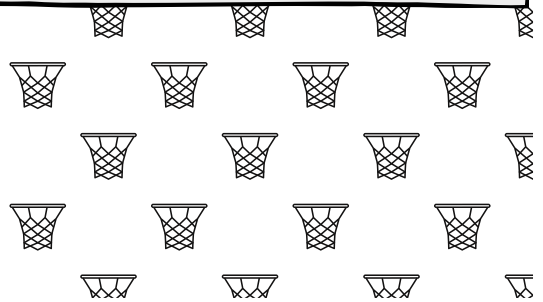


WHAT'S HAPPENING AROUND KORORO?

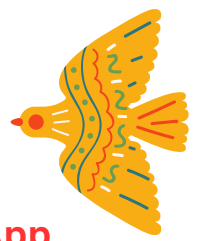

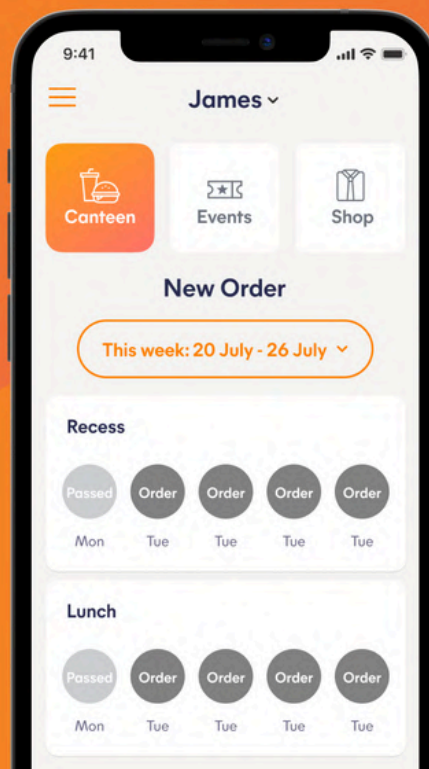

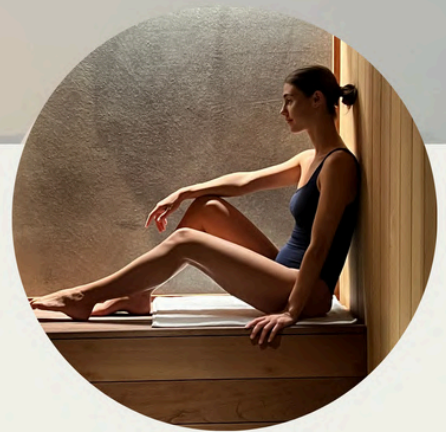
